

CANADIAN PLOWING ORGANIZATION SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The prevention of all accidents, particularly those involving personal injury or damage to equipment or property is paramount.

The Canadian Plowing Organization commits itself to implement and enforce the safety policy of host Provinces.

Where no declared policy exists, the Canadian Plowing Organization will ensure the following basic safety procedures are strictly enforced.

- 1. Passengers will not be allowed to ride on tractors or plows.*
- 2. Eye-protection goggles and gloves must be worn when using cutting/sharpening/grinding machines*
- 3. Eye-protection shields must be worn when electric welding. The C.P.O. recommends that welding booths be used as well to minimize the risk of glare to all.*
- 4. Electrical equipment must be properly installed and grounded. Care should be taken to ensure electrical extension cables are not run over by tractors or other vehicles or equipment.*
- 5. The sharp edges of spare coulters and skimmers must be guarded. These coulters and skimmers should always be laid flat and not transported or left in an upright position without protection.*
- 6. The C.P.O. recommends the installation of cabs or roll-over bars on all tractors.*
- 7. The instructions of the Marshalling Yard Supervisor and Parade Directors **MUST BE OBEYED.***
